Appendix 1 – Requirements for proficiency in English for the PhD Programme in Nautical Operations

English proficiency can be certified by any of the following tests:

- **TOEFL:** Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 580 (paper-based)/ 213 (computer-based)/ 85 (Internet-based).
- **IELTS:** International English Language Testing Service (IELTS) with a minimum of 6.5 points
- **APIEL:** Advanced Placement International English Language Examination (APIEL) with a minimum of 3 points
- **MELAB:** Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB) with a minimum of 85 points
- **University of Cambridge Exams:** *Certificate in Advanced English* or *Certificate of Proficiency in English*

Some categories of applicants are exempt from the English test requirement. These categories are listed under the following link:

Applicants meeting the following criteria are normally exempt after being interviewed by the home institution:

- completion of a 2-year Master's degree programme with a Master's thesis written in English and English as the language of instruction and examination.
- completion of a 5-year integrated Master's degree programme with a Master's thesis written in English and English as the language of instruction and examination for the last two years of the programme at least.
